## **Just For Fun Class Rules**

The Just For Fun class is intended to provide an entry level class for participants to become familiar with NPRC. While racers will run heads up against other Just For Fun participants, there will be no class winner named – after all, this is Just For Fun. \*\*Note – This is a dry tire class. No tire prep of any kind is permitted.\*\*

- Car: Any commonly available electric RC car is permitted.
- Motor: Any commonly available (instore or online) electric motor is permitted. Non-electric motors/engines of any kind are prohibited.
- Shocks: Must have four shocks each controlling a wheel as intended by typical manufacturers. Connected and operating hinge pin arms at all four corners of the car. Shocks must have movement visible and acceptable by the Race Director.
- Transmission: Any transmission (gear box) is permitted.
- Weight: Any car weight is permitted.
- Wheelie Bar: Any wheelie bar is permitted and is not required.
- Body: Must be a realistic looking style body.
- Wings/Spoilers: Any wing/spoiler is permitted.
- Nose Splitters: Any nose splitter is permitted.
- Rear Body Cutouts: Any rear body cutouts are permitted.
- Body holes: Any body holes are permitted.
- Tire Prep: No tire prep of any kind is allowed. Common cleaning agents such as Simple Green, Brake Cleaner, and Naptha are allowed but all tires must be dry to the touch at tech.
- Drivers Assist: "Assist" receivers are permitted.
- Cars will be teched for tire prep voltage prior to each run, and other requirements based on driver protest.
- Races will be run on a 132' track.
